
2016 CAA Carriage Festival July 1–3 at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington

Carriage Showcase

Kentucky Horse Park Campground

The Kentucky Horse Park's Campground offers 260 spacious sites with 50/30/20 amp electric, and water. All sites are 55-foot paved back-ins with fire rings and picnic tables. Two dump stations are provided.

Be sure to book early, as the CAA Carriage Festival falls on a holiday weekend this year! The summer holidayweekend rate is \$40 per night, with a five-night minimum stay. Check-in is at 2:00 p.m., and check-out is 12:00 noon. All guests must check in at the Campground store upon arrival, before going to their site.
