

- A tour-wheeled covered carriage peculiar to Turkey
- Public street vehicles intended to accommodate a large number of passengers
- 5. A Four-in-hand Coach, intended for private use
- 6. A funeral coach

- Type of cart peculiar to South Africa, usually made with pole and canvas top
