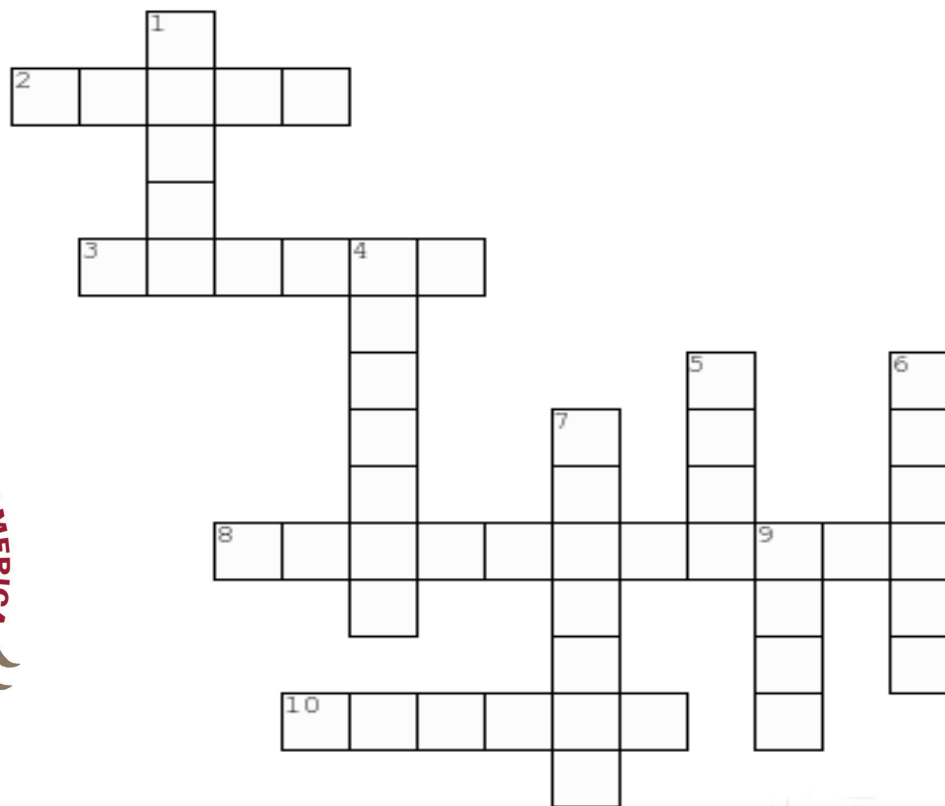

- 7.** Not named after a drink but rather because of its ability to whisk or turn around easily
- 9.** Type of cart peculiar to South Africa, usually made with pole and canvas top
