
HOTEL BRISTOL

Kaerntner Ring 1, Vienna, Austria, 1010

The Hotel Bristol Vienna provides the perfect home base for the CAA trip. Located in the heart of the city on the famous Ringstrasse (known as the the Champs-Élysées of Austria) & adjacent to the Vienna State Opera, the hotel is in close proximity to all major sights and some of the best restaurants & cafes in the city (including five Michelin-starred restaurants within walking distance). Albertina Museum and its collection of works from Monet to Picasso is a two minute walk from the Hotel. The Bristol - an art deco gem - has been one of Vienna's prime addresses since 1892 and serves as a living example of Viennese charm and personalized service.

Guest rooms and suites at the Hotel Bristol feature historically-inspired luxurious accommodations with fin de siècle antiques, chandeliers, and modern amenities. Some rooms overlook the Vienna State Opera house and are named after leading directors.

The Bristol Lounge offers all-day dining and enchants guests with its stylish elegance and tasteful décor.

Schönbrunn Palace is the magnificent summer retreat of the Hapsburg Emperors, built to rival the sprawling Château de Versailles. In 1569, Holy Roman Emperor Maximilian II erected the original hunting lodge here and called it Schönbrunn, meaning "beautiful spring." The 1,441 room Rococo palace, surrounded by 400 acres of sumptuous gardens, is one of the most important architectural, cultural, and historical monuments in Austria.

Enjoy a private guided tour of the Imperial apartments and state rooms in the Palace, lunch, and a private guided tour of Schönbrunn's magnificent Gardens.

Tuesday we return to Schönbrunn Palace for a day at the **Imperial Carriage Museum**. The Group will be accompanied by the Museum Director Dr. Monica Kurzel-Runtscheiner and Curator Dr. Mario Döberl.

In 1922 the most important part of the collection of the carriages used for the Imperial family and the Viennese court, including state coaches, ceremonial and gala carriages, sleighs, and sedan chairs, were transferred from the Imperial Court Stables at the Vienna Hofburg Palace to Schönbrunn.

Housed in the former winter riding school of the Palace, the Imperial Carriage Museum transports you straight to the glamorous world of the Habsburg Emperors.

The Lipizzaner stud farm Piber pursues a very important and responsible task: the breeding of the oldest cultural horse breed in Europe - the world-famous Lipizzaners.

The stud, with its surrounding farms and picturesque alpine pastures, is the home base of the white horses: their home from childhood, their school and leisure domicile in their youth, and their retirement residence after successful performances in Vienna at the Spanish Riding School.

The only institution in the world which for 450 years has practiced classical equitation in the Renaissance tradition of the Haute Ecole – which can also be found on UNESCO's list of the intangible cultural heritage of humanity. The School is housed in the magnificent 18th century Winter Riding School at the Hofburg Imperial Palace, home to the Hapsburg Emperors.




